# Overview

---

Configures multiple-connected devices simultaneously

- **Mobile Device Management** (MDM) software
- Updates iOS
- Locks screen and wallpaper
- Names each device
- Installs apps and documents
- Sets up configuration profiles
- Creates backup of device settings and data
- Restores backup to other devices



**Prepare Devices**

# Prepare Devices

---

Devices need to be (1) **prepared** before being (2) **supervised** and (3) **assigned** to users

- Configures up to 30 devices at one time
- Updates devices to latest iOS version
- Creates and restores a backup of settings and app data
- Imports apps into Apple Configurator and syncs them to new devices
- Creates and installs iOS configuration profiles

**Prepare Devices**  
Prep your iOS devices for mass deployment.

Configure your organization's devices. Quickly update them to the latest iOS version, install profiles, install free and volume purchased apps, or restore a device backup. [Learn more](#)

**Supervise Devices**  
Enforce a standard configuration on your iOS devices.

Maintain control over groups of devices that share common apps, settings, and profiles. Automatically restore devices to the specified configuration when reconnected. [Learn more](#)

**Assign Devices**  
Assign iOS devices to users in your organization.

Create and manage users and groups. Assign supervised devices to individual users, back up and restore users' content and settings, and distribute and retrieve users' documents. [Learn more](#)


# Supervise Devices

---


One designated person on campus has **ongoing control** over all mobile devices

- Automatically applies common configuration to supervised devices
- Quickly reapplies configuration to a device and then removes the previous user's data
- Imports apps into Apple Configurator and syncs them to supervised devices
- Defines and applies common or sequential names to all devices
- Restrict supervised devices from syncing with other computers

# Assign Devices

---

One designated person on campus has **ongoing control** over all mobile devices

- **Add** users and groups
- **Check out** a device to a user and restore the user's settings and data on that device
- **Check in** a device from a user and back up the data for later use
- **Apply** custom text, wallpaper, or pictures to a device's Lock screen
- Import, export, and sync documents between assigned devices and Apple Configurator
