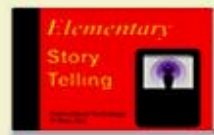

Some digital stories include the entire class, while others use a smaller group of selected students. Video length is generally 2 to 10 minutes.

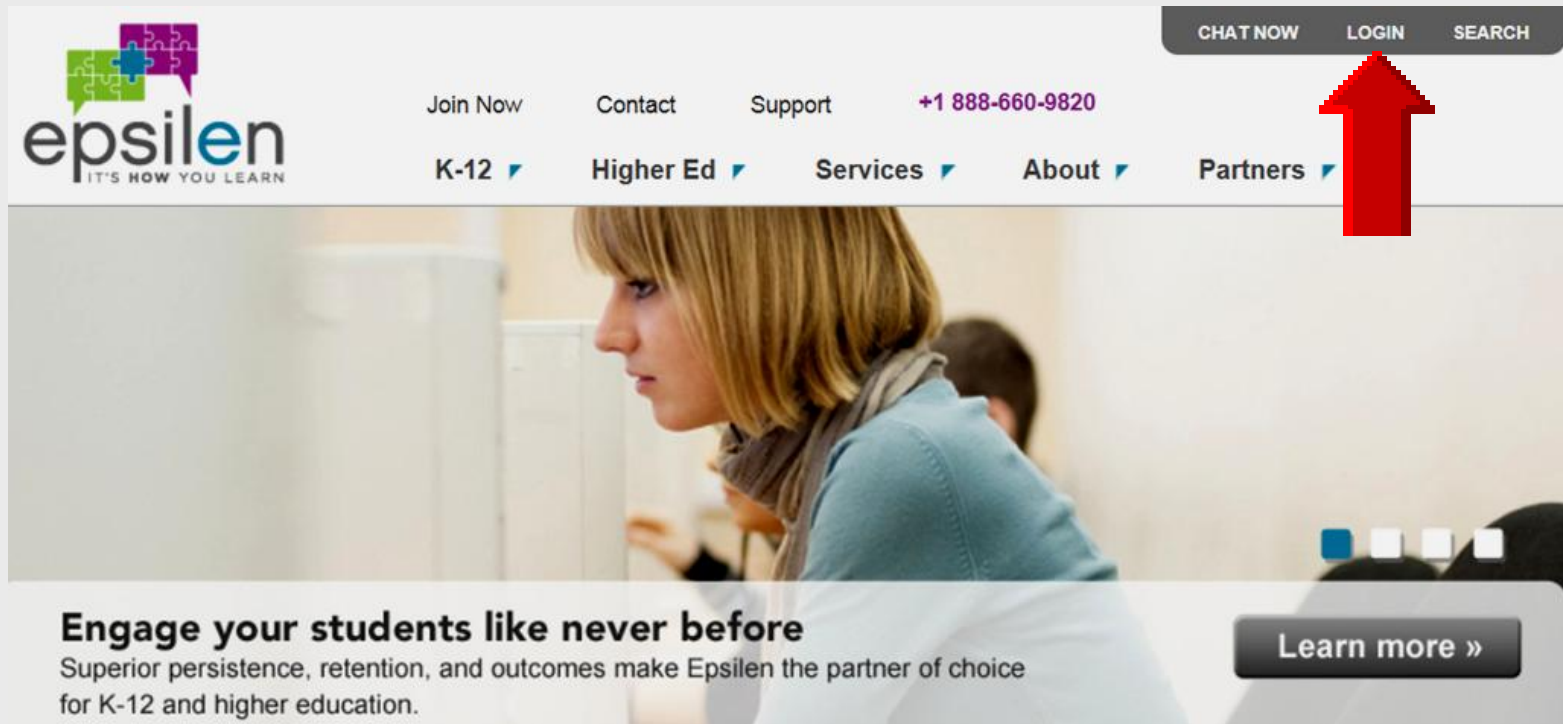


