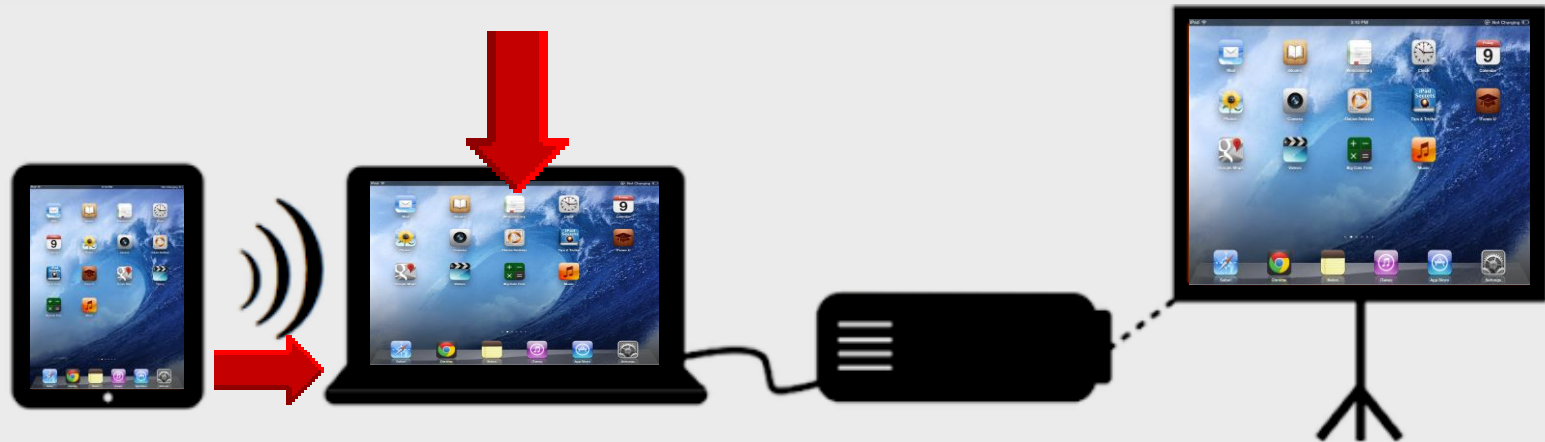

Doceri – installed on Win7 laptop + iPad app – **1 license**

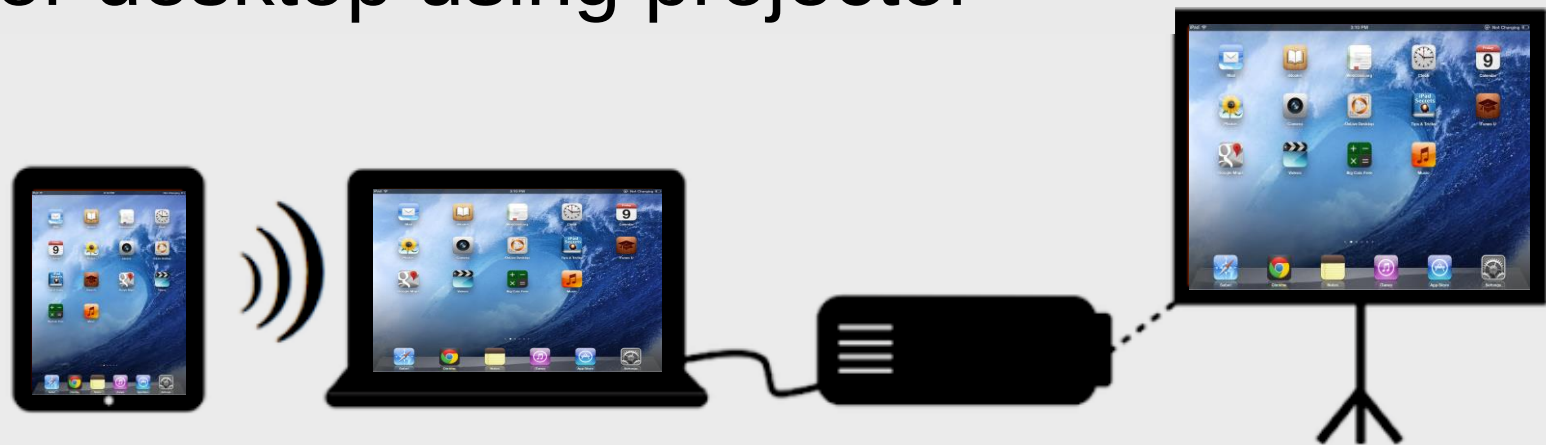

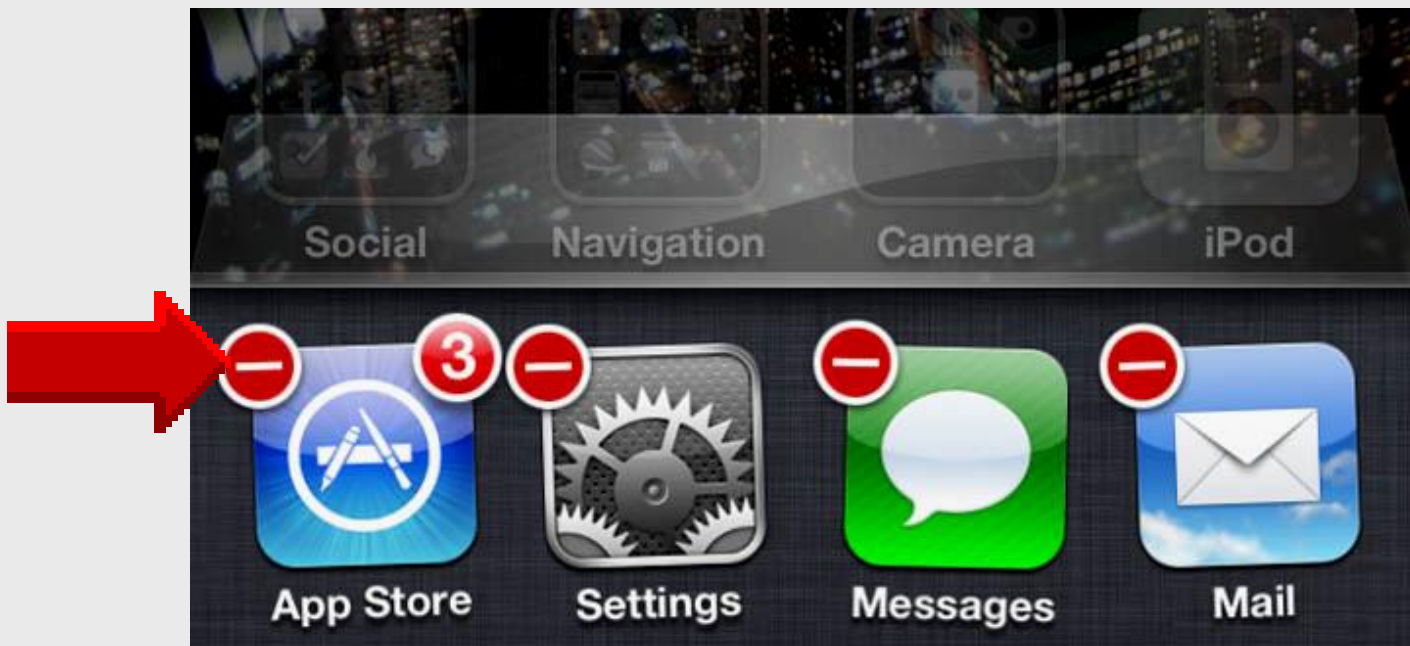


Multi-tasking Bar



Close Open Apps

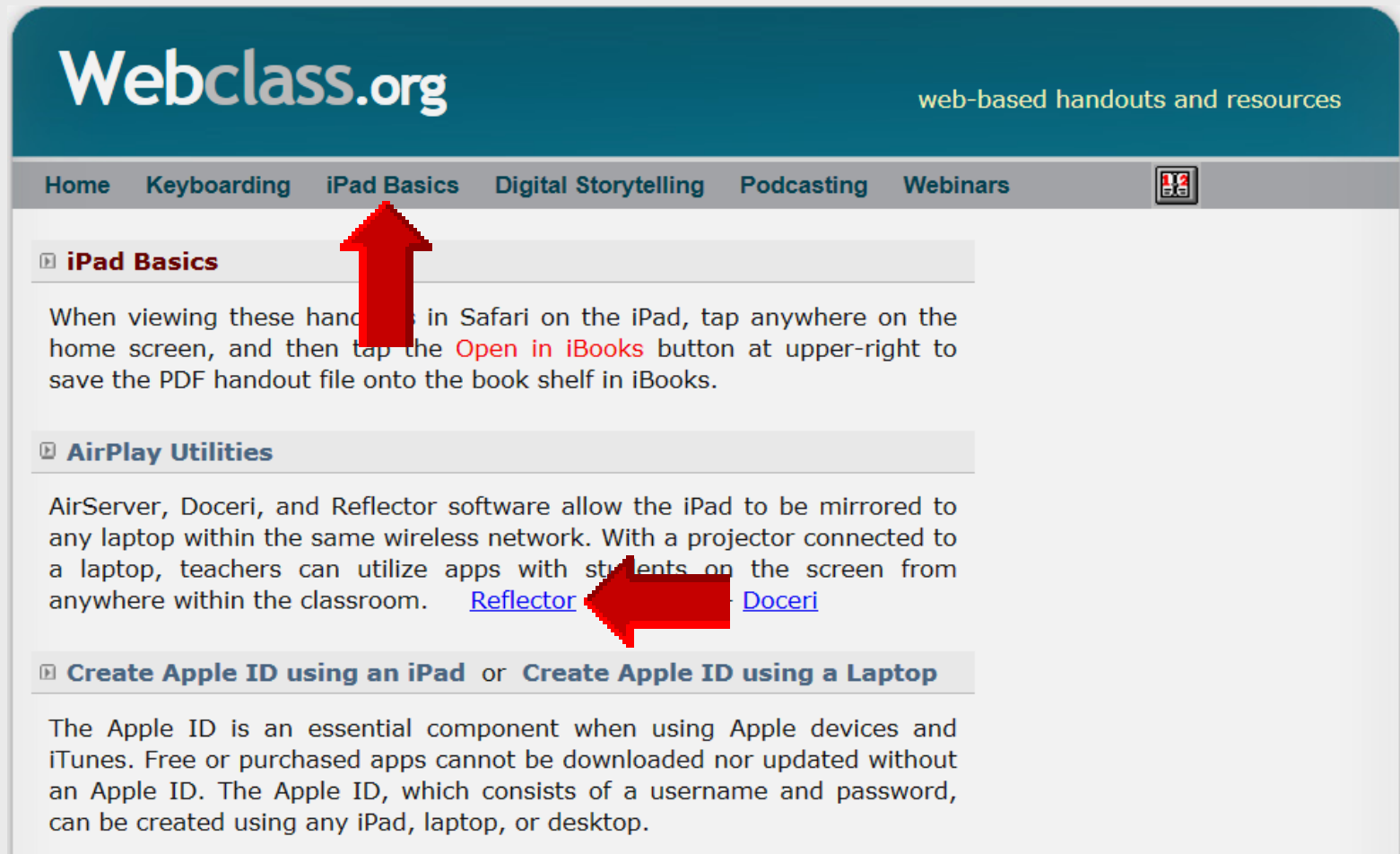
1. Press **Home** button twice for **taskbar**

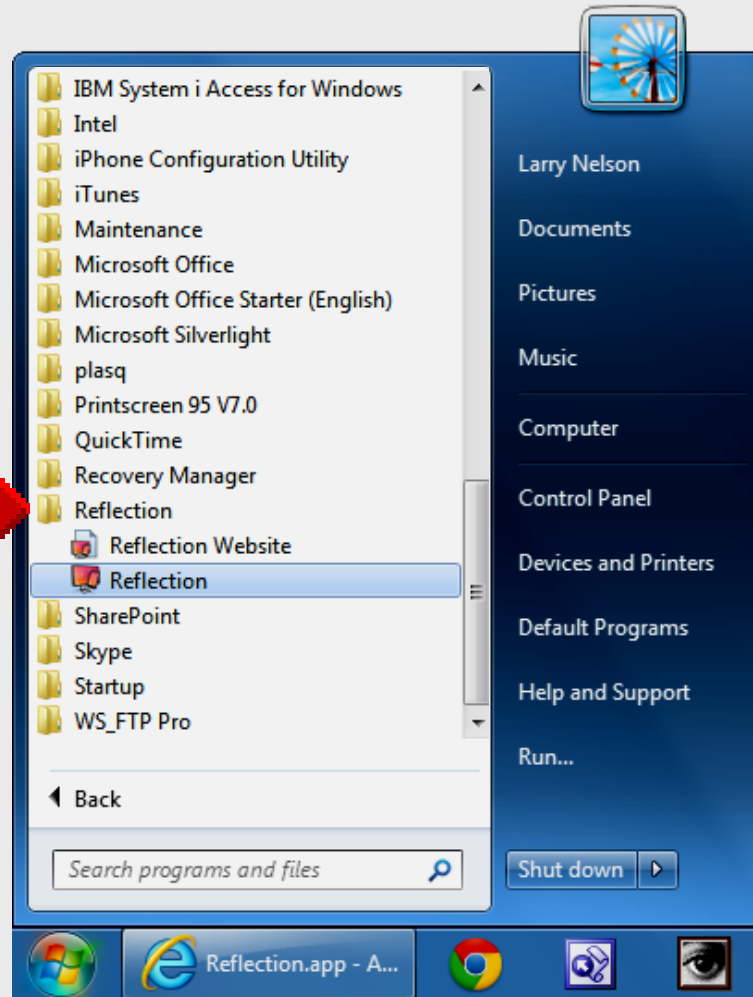

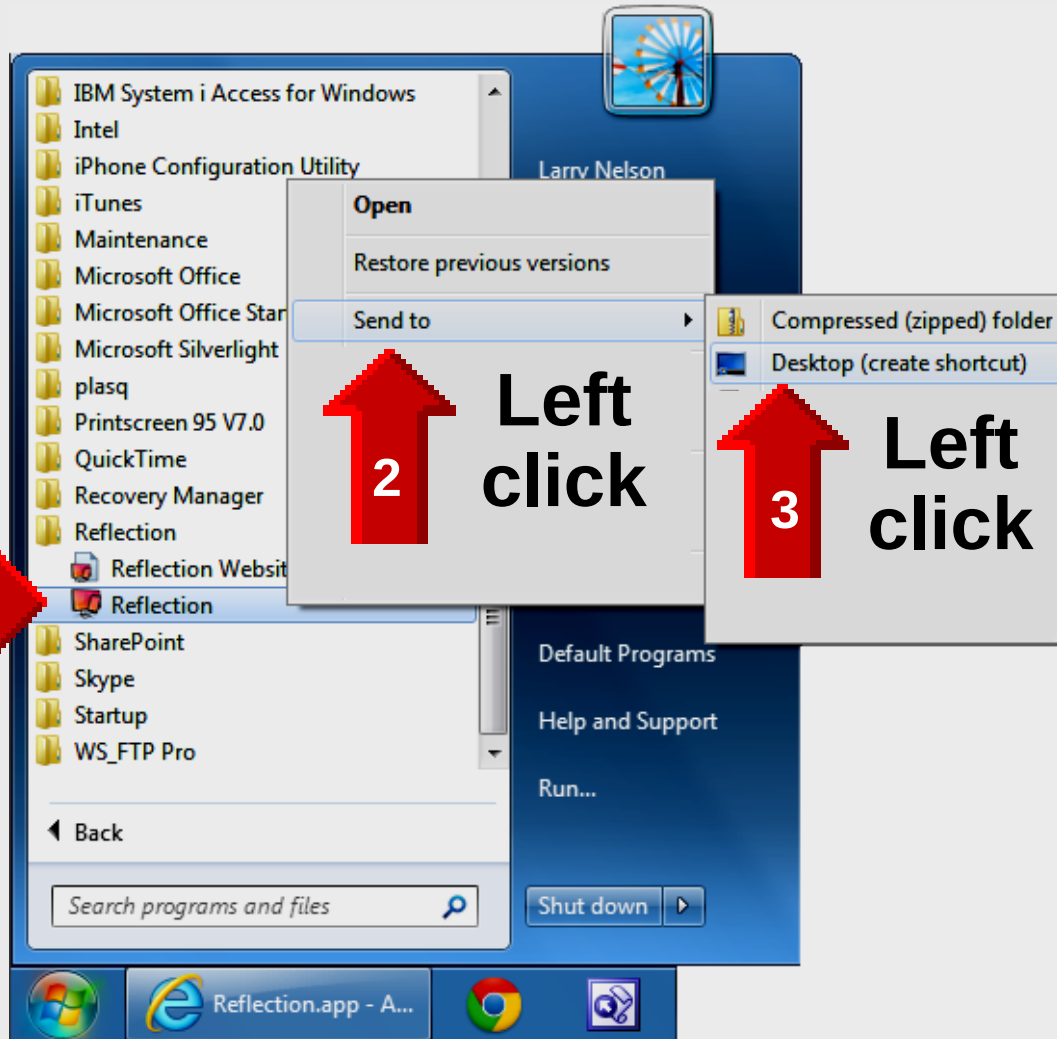

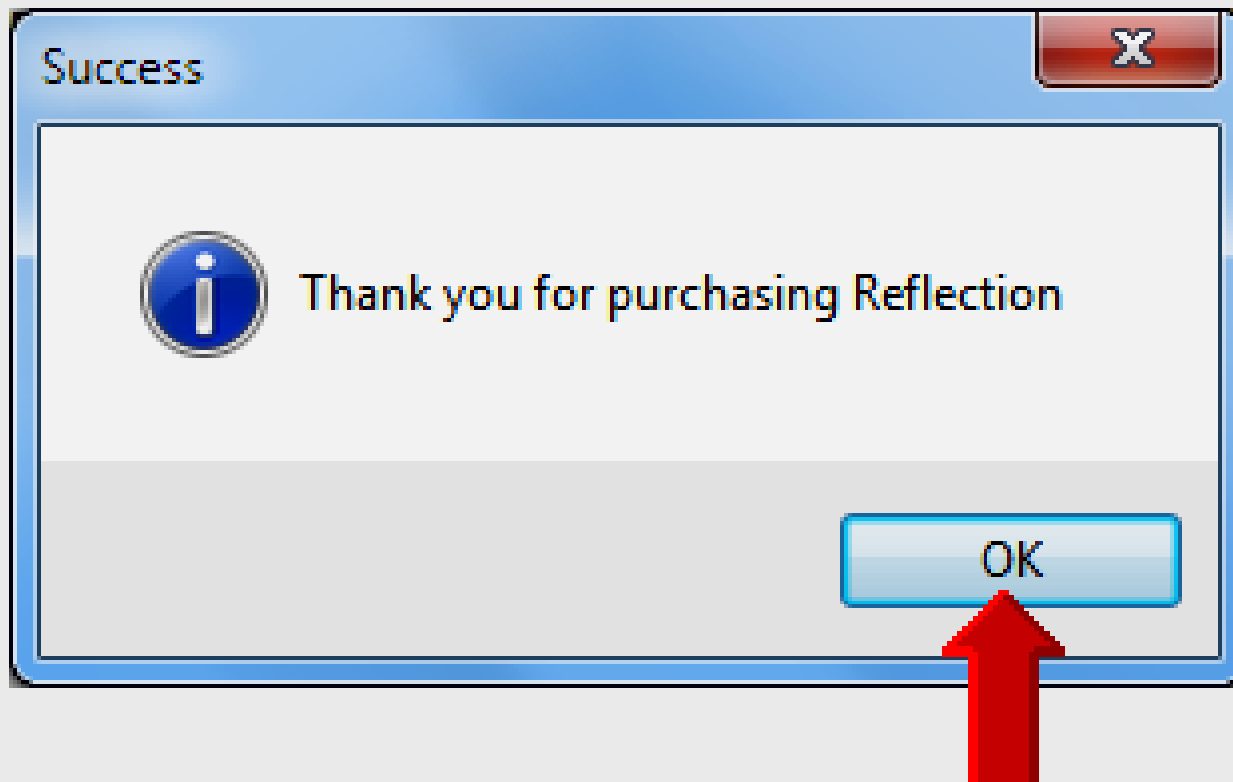


Register Reflector

 - Reflector simply runs in background on the system tray

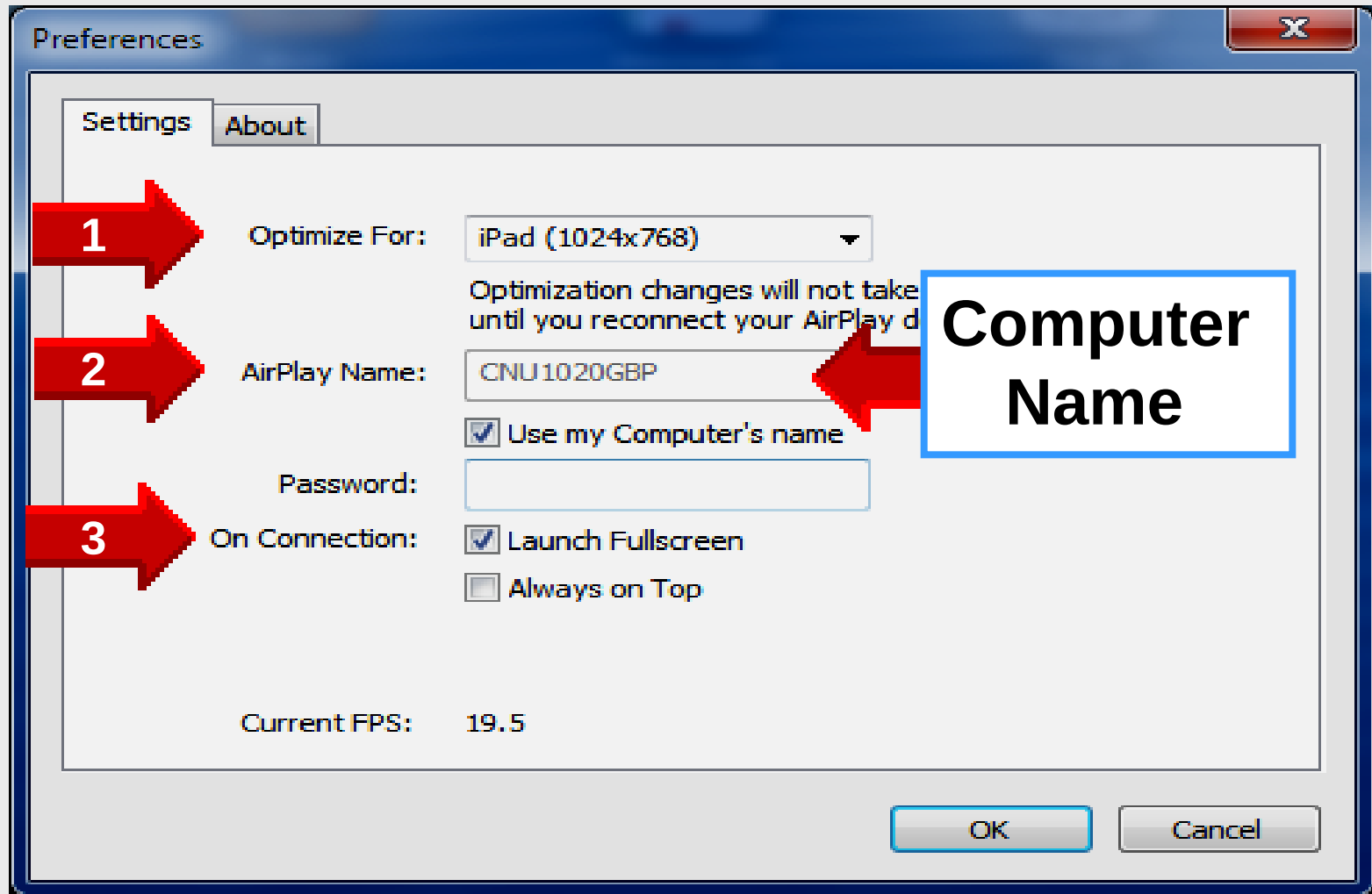

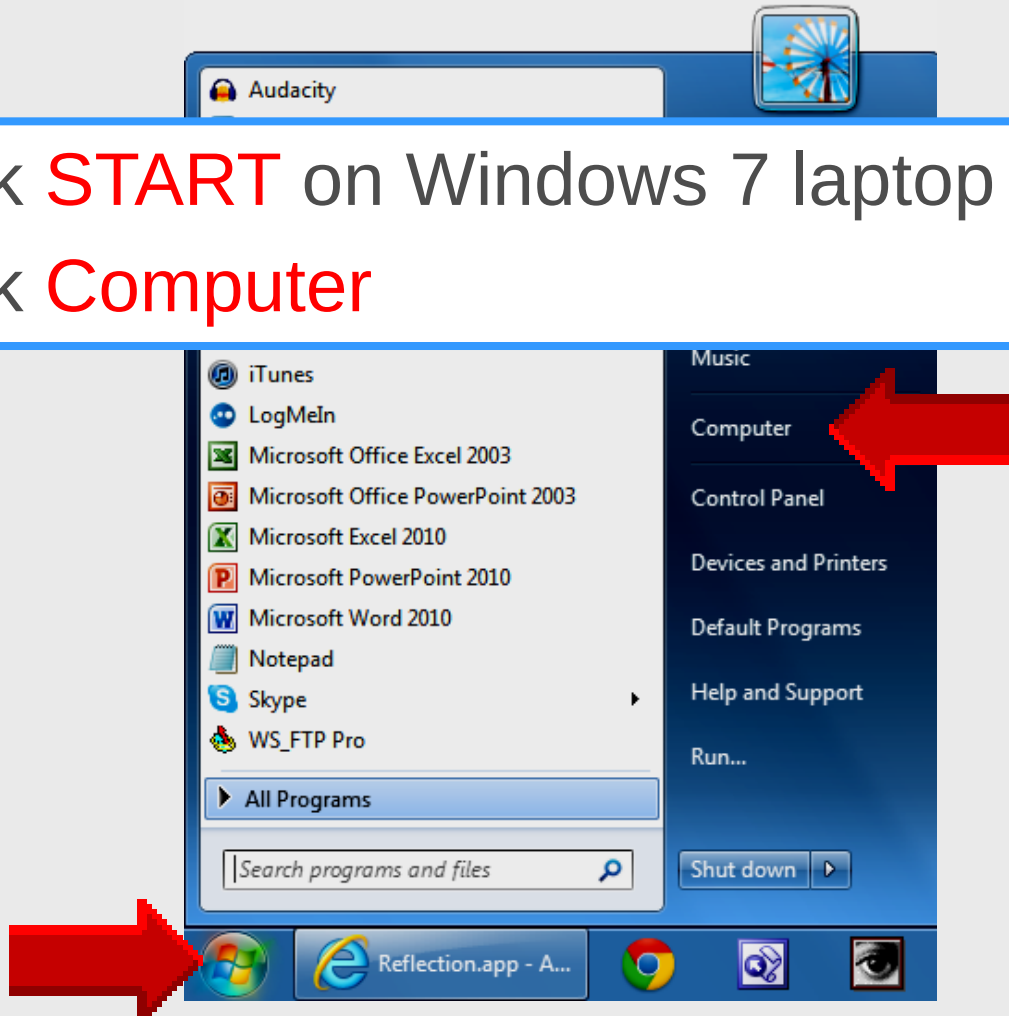

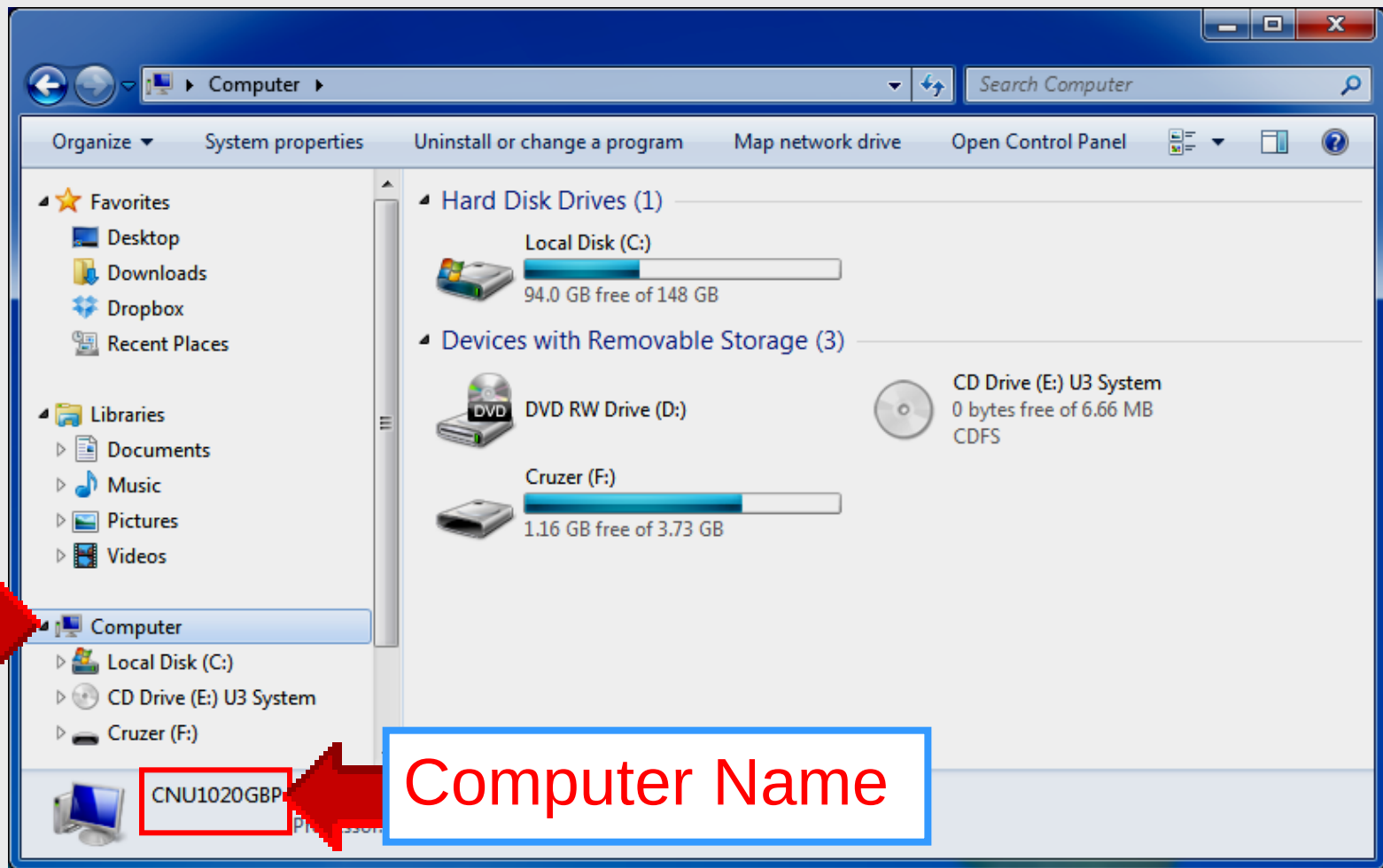

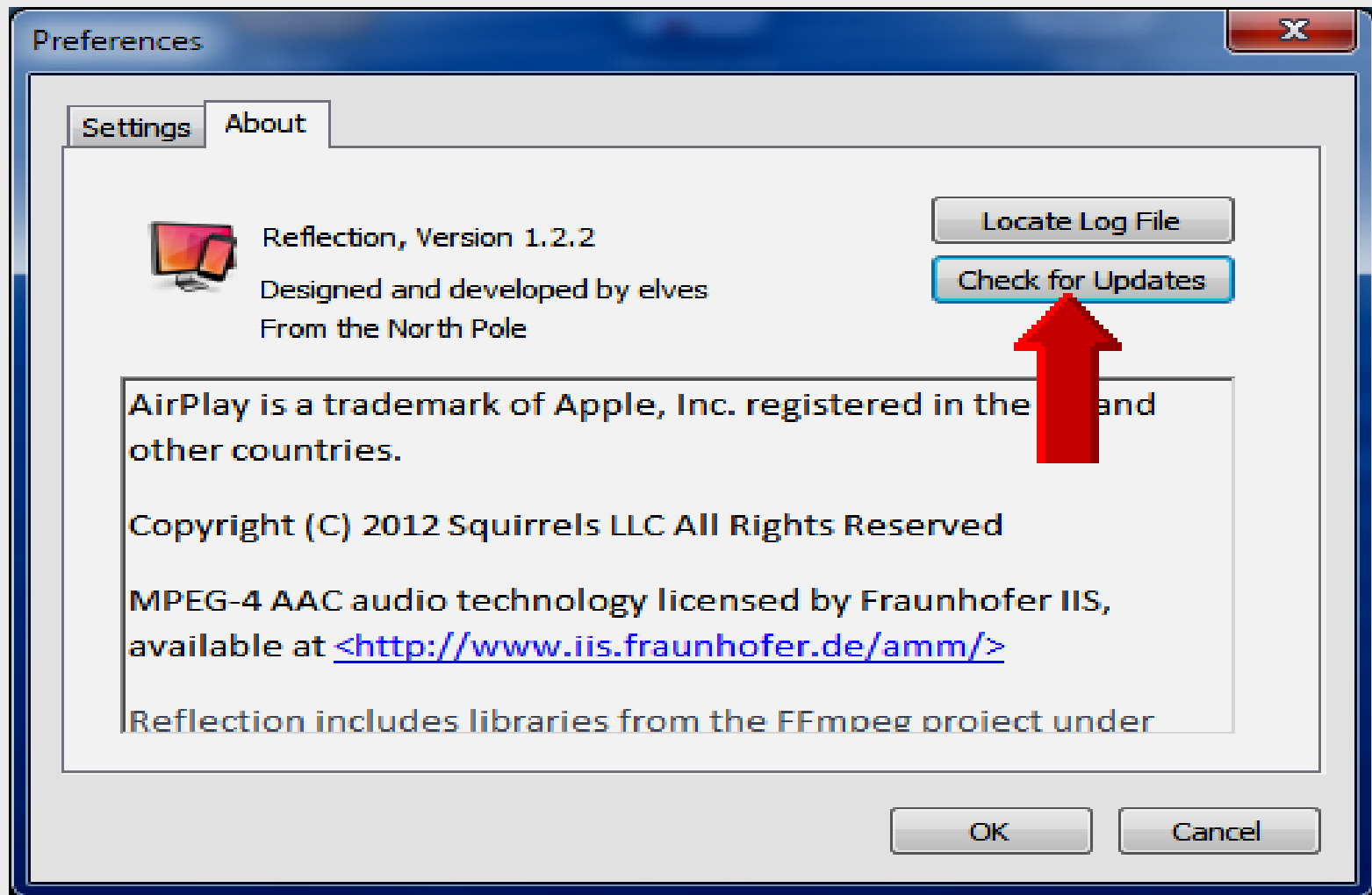

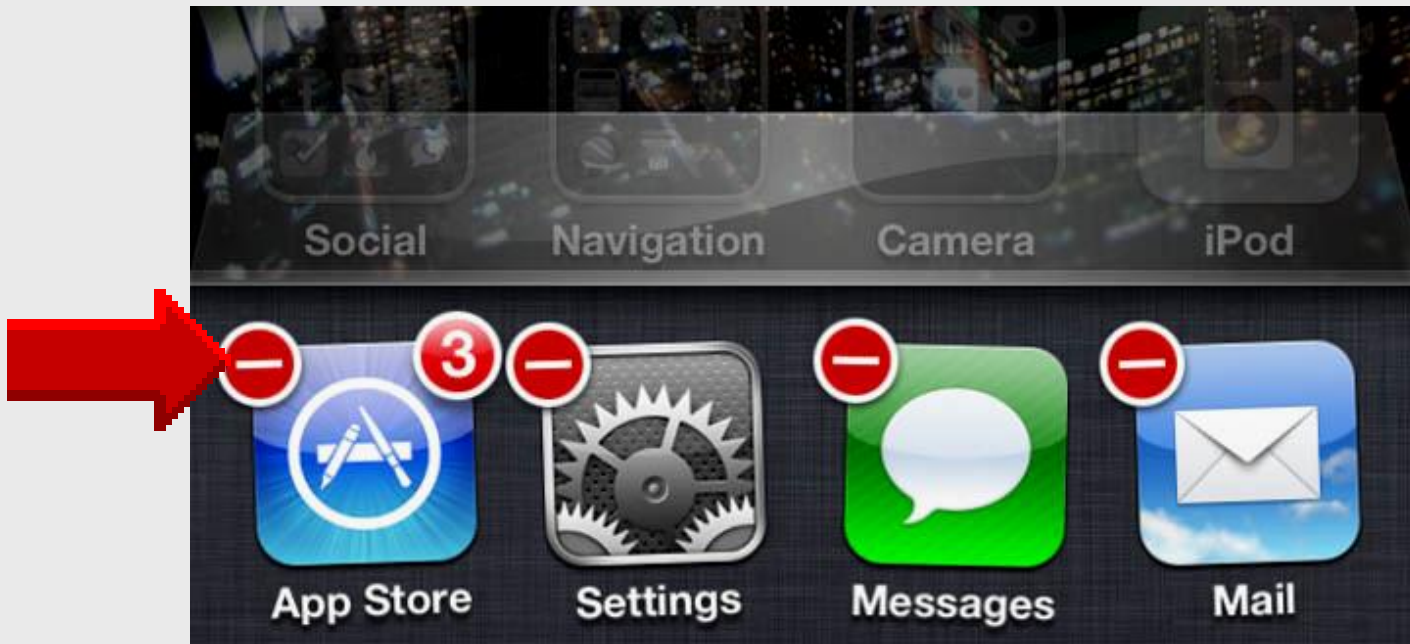
