## What is Podcasting

Podcasting is a method of publishing audio or video files on the Internet. Any teacher with a computer, a microphone, and an Internet connection can create an MP3 audio file, and publish a podcast. In its simplest form, a podcast is nothing more than an audio file saved within a web page.

The word **podcasting** was first coined in February 2004. It combines the word **broadcasting** with Apple's MP3 player - the **iPod**. However, podcasts do not require a portable player like the iPod. Any digital audio player, such as Windows Media Player or Apple's QuickTime, can play an audio podcast.

An audio or video podcast could include:

1. An audio introduction to the class
2. Vocabulary/spelling words read aloud by the teacher
3. Additional audio instructions for homework
